

Statement of Belief

We believe the Bible to be the infallible, verbally inspired Word of God, inerrant in the original writings, and the final authority for faith and practice. We believe in one triune God eternally existing in three coequal Persons--Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Established in 1946, Cumberland Springs is one of the longest running Christian camps in this area. As has been true since the camp was opened, rules for acceptance and participation are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, national origin, or handicap.

Cumberland Springs Bible Camp

Christian camping offers a unique opportunity for ministry. Many Christian adults cite camp as the place where they made significant spiritual decisions.

Camps and retreats at Cumberland Springs are designed to help campers mature physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Campers get away from their regular routine and are placed into an environment that includes enjoyable and challenging outdoor activities, interaction with committed counselors and staff, and solid Bible teaching. This combination of factors serves as a catalyst for salvation or spiritual growth.

CSBC currently offers summer camps and spring and fall retreats. Our regular camp activities include: swimming, hiking, archery, crafts, canoeing, campouts, cookouts, nature games, campfire programs, initiative games, group Bible studies, orienteering, and daily chapel. All activities are tailored to specific age groups and are conducted in a non-threatening, inclusive style. We want our campers to have fun and to go home changed people.

Campers attend CSBC by paying a modest fee or by completing a Bible correspondence course to obtain tuition credit. Our fees are kept low by the donations of churches and individuals and through the sacrifice of summer staff who volunteer their time or receive a limited salary. Full-time staff raise their own financial support.

Our campers come through word of mouth and from area churches. We are seeking churches and individuals that would partner with us by sending campers as individuals or groups, by enrolling campers in the Mail Box Club, or by supporting the camp ministry or full-time staff financially. We would welcome the opportunity to visit your church and present our program and needs.

TMM Ministries

TMM Ministries was founded in 1938 by Rev. and Mrs. A.J. Levensgood. In the first few years, the Levensgoods taught Bible classes in communities in rural East Tennessee where there were no established churches. Gradually their emphasis came to be centered around visits to public schools. They soon added a Bible memory program, whereby awards were given to those children who memorized a specified list of Bible verses. The final award was a week of Bible camp.

At first the Bible camp was held at nearby Fall Creek Falls State Park or at Bryan College. In 1945, TMM purchased our current camp grounds, a former summer resort known as Cumberland Springs.

Today, TMM Ministries operates Cumberland Springs Bible Camp, administers Mail Box Club Bible correspondence courses, hosts an Adult Ladies Fellowship, and makes the CSBC facilities available to churches and like-minded groups for camps, conferences, retreats, and reunions. Our facility is suitable for year-round retreats and meetings.

TMM Ministries is a faith ministry and is not affiliated with any denomination. The work is supported by churches and individuals who feel led of God to support the ministry with prayer, finances, and volunteer labor.
