

Statement of Belief

Typical CSBC Schedule

- Camps are in June and July.
- One week of Staff Training (early June).
- Two weeks of Junior Camp (9 - 12 years).
- One week of Teen Camp (13 - 18 years).
- A week off around July 4th.
- Two weeks of Day Camp (6 - 12 years).
- Spring and Fall weekend retreats.
- Work for part or all of summer is available.

Finances

- Program instructors, senior counselors, and assistant counselors receive a small salary. Junior staff are asked to volunteer.
- Summer staff may represent their work at CSBC as mission work and raise additional support. We will assist in the logistics of raising support.

- Camper fees are kept low so that CSBC is accessible to all.
